Did you know?

We assist approximately 25 million Americans annually, in every ZIP code in the U.S.

FOOD

More that 41.2 million Americans live in food-insecure households.



CHILD PROTECTION

Almost 20% of juvenile violent crimes occur between 3 p.m. and 7 p.m on school days.



These nationwide programs keep 250,000 kids safe, fed, and engaged.

SHELTER

Every year, 1 in every 30 children in the U.S. experiences homelessness.
