At The Salvation Army, we are dedicated to one thing:

DOING THE MOST GOOD

So, what exactly *do* we do?

 Did you know?

We assist approximately 25 million Americans annually, in every ZIP code in the U.S.

FOOD

More than 41.2 million Americans live in food-insecure households.

 We serve more than **56.3 MILLION** meals per year

SHELTER

Every year, 1 in every 30 children in the U.S. experiences homelessness. (That's 2.5 million.)

 We provide **10.3 MILLION** nights of shelter

REHABILITATION

The Salvation Army assists more than 200,000 people annually in 141 rehabilitation facilities.

 We have more treatment facilities than any charity, anywhere.

DISASTER RELIEF

When a disaster strikes, The Salvation Army stays on scene to assure long-term recovery, for as long as it takes.

 We deliver relief to an average of **272,000** * people annually

CHILD PROTECTION

Almost 20% of juvenile violent crimes occur between 3 p.m. and 7 p.m on school days.

 We host more than **400** children's programs

These nationwide programs keep 250,000 kids safe, fed, and engaged.

POVERTY RELIEF


40.6 million Americans live in poverty.

 **3.3 MILLION**
The Salvation Army works to give a hand up, not a handout, through our 3.3 million volunteers...

...and 7,600 centers of operation.

COMMUNITY SUPPORT

12 million Americans are considered working poor.

 The Salvation Army operates community centers that serve **1.4 MILLION** people annually.

ANTI-TRAFFICKING

The Salvation Army actively seeks to prevent and protect victims of human trafficking.

 We assist over **300** people with long-term case management in **15** centers across the country.
